I invite your attention to the references cited and to inform that exposure of weaker section students to quality education is the main task of the Government so as to achieve social equality. To achieve this, Government is implementing the Scheme of “Admission of Meritorious poor Students belonging to SC/ST/BC/MW into Reputed Private Junior Colleges”. Student who get admission under the scheme will get Rs.38,000/- per annum (Rs.35,000-tuition fee and Rs.3000/-pocket money). The students who get 7 and above GPA are eligible to apply. The selection is automated based on the priority of colleges choose by the student. There are 3238 seats available under the scheme. Of them 1327 are for SCs, 604 for STs, 738 for BCs, 215 for BC-C,183 for EBCs and171 for Minority. 3% of these seats are earmarked for Disabled students. 60% seats shall be allocated to Girls and 40% shall be allocated to Boys.

Further all these seats will be allotted to the students studied in the following institutions as per the percentage fixed by the Govt. The details are as follows;

Category	Description of category	Percentage of allocation
I	Students of Hostels, Ashram Schools and KGBVs	50%
II	Students of Govt, Municipal, Z.P and Aided Schools	25%
III	Students of Residential Schools (SW&TW) & Navodya Vidyalayas	20%
IV	Students of Best Available Schools (SW&TW)	5%

Andhra Pradesh SSC results 2015 are going to be declared on 20.05.2015.


The District Selection Committee headed by the District Collector shall short list the Reputed Junior Colleges basing on the following criteria:

PTO

- a. Good sufficient residential accommodation.
- b. Adequate infrastructure facilities for Class rooms, Dormitory, Hostels etc.,
- c. Consistent academic track record with more than 90% passes with at least 50% securing 1st classes.
- d. Consistent high success rate in admission tests like IIT/JEE etc.,
- e. Experienced faculty.

In order to admit the students in reputed private junior colleges under the scheme micro level action plan is needed. An action plan is prepared involving all stake holders, i.e, District Welfare Officers, Field Level Welfare Officers, MEOs, Principals of Residential Schools, epass officials etc, is enclosed for taking necessary action.

I, therefore, request you to kindly bestow personal attention in the admission process and see that good colleges having qualified faculty and sufficient infrastructure with Hostel accommodation are selected and all the eligible students are enrolled under the scheme.
